## **Stagiaire d'anglais - ESIEE-Amiens - France**

ESIEE-Amiens (Ecole Supérieure d'Ingénieurs en Electronique et Electrotechnique) is currently looking for English language assistants (not through the British Council) to work in the English department. The ESIEE-Amiens is a specialist engineering school (university level) in the north of France around one hour from Paris. The job of English language assistant involves speaking practice with the students (general conversation, not related to engineering), helping students prepare for their compulsory English exams / tests (PET, FCE, CAE, Linguaskill), updating and creating new material for the language centre and occasional translation work for the school. You will be paid between 500€ & 550€ per month (the standard 'stagiaire' wage) and in addition the school reimburses 130€ for your rent. The school can also offer you accommodation or help you to find your own independently. You will work every day from 9 till 5 including a one hour lunch break. Although the working hours are significantly longer than those of the British Council assistants, since you will be working with students of your own age the job presents a great opportunity to mix with French students. The working environment is pleasant and all the staff and students at the school are very welcoming.

Ideally situated for visiting other major cities and towns in France and Europe, Amiens is a lovely place with a number of higher education institutions so there are always lots of students around.

There are two posts available, from **mid September 2020 to the end of June 2021**.

The school will, however, also consider applications from students who are splitting their year abroad between two countries to come for one term only. In this case we are relatively flexible with start and end dates :

- mid September to the end of December 2020 or to the end of January 2021,
- beginning of January **or** beginning of February 2021 to the end of June 2021.
